Why this Ministry is Important

The effectiveness of Men Abiding in Christ Ministries is based upon information that I can pass along to men. The information that I pass along is a culmination of experiences, knowledge, beliefs, and faith that has been learned from spending time with God, my family, church, job, and people like you.

The most important thing that I can do to enhance this ministry, next to spending time with God, is carving out time to spend with men. All of us have a unique story in experiencing God in our lives. Sometimes this experience is revealed through joyful times like a new relationship or a birth of a child. Sometimes, His grace is revealed/experienced through tough times, like a job loss, divorce, or a death of a friend or family member. It's the sharing of these experiences that help fuel this ministry.

Part of my calling is to have men share these experiences with each other so they can help each other grow in their relationship with Christ. That is why I have a passion to start small groups in the marketplace, assist churches to develop relationship based ministries, and meet with men one-on-one. It is through these avenues that I minister. For these men to see my passion, it is imperative that I minister from the overflow of my passion for Christ.

The impact of this ministry will be seen through the longevity of its existence and the contact work that I do. My struggle (as I am already seeing) will be trusting God for the provisions to sustain this calling and making time to be fed through God and people like you.

Over the long run, this ministry will reach thousands of people found in the networks of each of our lives. It is through this network, where one is given the desire of "wanting what that person has" because they sense something missing in their own life.

I ask for your prayers as I continue to seek supporters for this ministry. We need to raise \$2000 dollars more in monthly contributions to reach our minimum goal. I also ask for your prayers as I start a 3rd small group to lead during the week and as I continue to make contact with churches in seeking an opportunity to further God's kingdom.

Thank you again for being a part of this ministry. What I gain from you through our relationships is passed forward to someone else to serve God in building this community known for it's faithfulness to Jesus Christ.
